This has some aromatic depth for Grenache, ripe plums and dark berry fruits, some sweet cinnamon spice and sandy/earthy nuances, a little regional licquorice, pure and intense. The palate packs a core of rich, deep sweet fruit flavour, intense dark ripe berries, savoury tannins quench the finish. Terrific presence.

The 2005 Grenache was aged in French oak, 15% new. Opaque purple, it offers aromas of smoke, pencil lead, black cherry, black raspberry, plum, and raisins. This leads to a succulent wine with gobs of sweet fruit, excellent balance, a long pure finish. Drink this tasty effort through 2020.
